They first started supplying the site in August 2020 after a local youth project, The Zone, put them in touch with Vattenfall. With work just getting underway on site, but covid restrictions in place, the project team wanted to contract a local business to supply hot, filled breakfast rolls to site every Friday morning.

Owner Billy Loy said: "We wouldn't normally put ourselves out there for this sort of corporate contract, but 2020 had been a year of real ups and downs, so we decided to give it a go. After all, if we didn't try, someone else would!

"When the first lockdown hit that spring, we'd had to close and furlough staff, and when we did re-open it was for collections only, so the Vattenfall contract has been a welcome boost."

Together with his wife and son, Billy now prepares and delivers a large order to the site team every Friday morning, "They're always happy to see me driving up the hill to the site gate with a boot full of hot, bacon rolls!"
